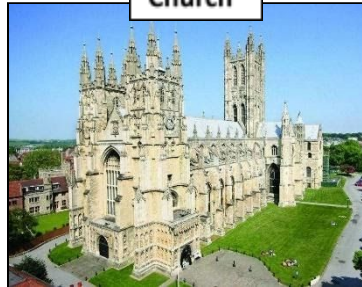


**The King**
